In the COFUND 2016 call Spain obtained 19,41M€ (27,54% EU 28), being the first country with the highest return, with 8 projects financed ([see news](#)).

Currently, 3 Spanish institutions have already signed Grant Agreements with the Commission, thus allowing different funded programs to start in the next months.
