

## Amber Workshop 2011 finishes after 4 intense days

**Barcelona, 10th May 2011.-** From May 3 to 6, the Barcelona Supercomputing Center (BSC) and the Institute for Research in Biomedicine (IRB Barcelona) organized the Amber Workshop sponsored by Nvidia. In total, 60 attendees from 13 different countries participated in this course taught by Professors Adrian E. Roitberg, University of Florida and Ross C. Walker, University of California San Diego. The workshop offered an introduction to the technique of simulation of molecules using the AMBER software in practical cases such as the prediction of the interaction between two bio-molecules. Participants had also the opportunity to know the features of the next version of software (AMBER12), which will include the portability to GPUs.
